

Don't overlook these **5 Clauses** in business contracts



Dispute Resolution

Establishes what happens in case of a conflict. All disputes don't go to court. Some might lead to mediation or arbitration - distinct legal procedures that require their own legal expertise.



Assignment Clause

Gives a party the chance to transfer ownership or assign their contractual obligations to a different contracting party.




Warranty Disclaimer

Narrows down the scope of the warranty clause by stating that unless there is an explicit warranty mentioned in the contract, all implied warranties are disclaimed.



Force Majeure

Grants parties immunity from adhering to a contract in case of a natural disaster or calamities.



Order Of Precedence

Defines the order in which various documents are prioritized in a contract, especially when resolving conflict within the said contract.
